ARTISTS OF WINDMORE

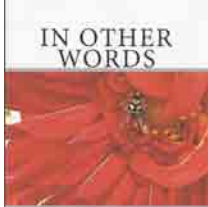
This is a diverse group of artists whose activities include workshops, plein air outings, field trips, art demos, critiques, classes and group shows. Participating members are invited to display their work. These opportunities include exhibiting and selling work in a variety of venues. Also, several times a year, Windmore selects a performing or visual artist as an "Artist of the Month". The artist is featured in one of Windmore's newspaper columns about the arts.



PEN-TO-PAPER WRITERS

Windmore's Pen-to-Paper Writers meet to share different genres, discuss publishing, perform readings, and to encourage young writers. The group uses art, music, writing exercises, and drama to stimulate creativity. Authors offer constructive criticism and support. New or experienced writers are welcome. Pen-to-Paper writers published Windmore's fourth anthology, *In Other Words* in June 2017.

Meetings for Pen-to-Paper are held at Culpeper Library on the first Tuesday of each month. Morning session is from 10 am to noon and evening meeting is from 5 pm to 7. Educational classes are determined by writers' suggestions.



STAGEWORKS THEATER

StageWorks Theater, a community theater group, provides on and off-stage opportunities for adults, teens, and children. The popular shows frequently sell out to full houses. The group produces theatrical performances, offers educational classes, and networks with local ensembles. Recent productions include *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown* and *Salt and Pepper*.

CROSSROADS YOUTH ORCHESTRA



Established in 2012, Crossroads Youth Orchestra serves five counties and is the only youth orchestra in Culpeper County.

Samuel Runolfson is the Conductor of Crossroads Youth Orchestra (CYO) which provides music education and concert performance opportunities for local youth ages 10 to 25. Mr. Runolfson holds a Master of Music in Cello Performance and a Bachelor of Music Education. Mr. Runolfson has conducted the Bonneville Youth Orchestra, Weber State Symphony Orchestra, Lincoln Youth Chamber Orchestra, Lincoln Youth Symphony, and Morgan Valley Chamber Orchestra. As an active musician, Mr. Runolfson, pictured here, (photo credit: "Only in Ogden" photography), currently performs as a cellist with local orchestras. CYO also offers a Strings Ensemble conducted by Dawn Fletcher who holds a degree in Instrumental Music and Music Theory. She has been teaching for eight years. CYO begins each year in August and auditions continue on a rolling basis throughout the year.
